Your information is confidential

To protect your privacy, you will need to log on using your Internet ID and PIN numbers. The information you provide must be kept confidential by Statistics New Zealand and is protected by the Statistics Act 1975. The Public Records Act 2005 requires that census forms be kept as historical records. After 100 years census forms may be made available for research that meets the confidentiality requirements of the Statistics Act.
